9. Prepare a work diary of Vegetable Printing on sarees.
10. Prepare any four questions based on the following activity.

Take a rexin piece of sheet 40 cm x 18 cm size. Fold it into two, such that the polished surface comes inside. Cut it with scissors along the line of fold, leaving 2 cms from either side. Stitch the zip and runner along the cut line properly. Stitch the other sides using back stitch, leaving 1cm from the edges. Open the zip and turn inside out the polished surface of the stitched ladies pouch. Stitch the hang belt at the two upper ends of the pouch. Now the ladies pouch is ready to use.
